The BFA degree requires a minimum of 125 units of which 42 must be upper-division units. (Upper-division courses are numbered 300-499). This major requires a minimum of 88 units of which at least 40 must be upper-division units. No more than 64 units total may be transferred from two-year college(s).

Musical Theatre Major Policies: Music and Dance

Bachelor of Fine Arts, Musical Theatre 2020-2021 Catalog

MUSIC:

The Music requirement for the Musical Theatre major includes 1 course in each of 3 areas:

[Music Notation/Theory]	TAR 130 (Music Theory for Musical Theatre Singers) – 3 units
[Piano Skills]	MUS 101A (Exploring Music through Piano) – 3 units
[Music Listening/History]	MUS 107 (Understanding Music through Listening) – 3 units -or- MUS 108 (Survey of Music, Meaning and Culture) – 3 units

Students with prior musical background and experience may be able to substitute more advanced music courses for the above courses; however, you must abide by the policies listed below. In all cases, course substitutions must have the written approval of your Musical Theatre major advisor.

[Music Notation/Theory]:

TAR 130 (Music Theory for Musical Theatre Singers) is usually taken in Fall of the freshman year. Your Musical Theatre advisor must approve any substitutions for this course.

[Piano Skills]:

If you already play piano, you should meet with UA piano professor Lisa Zdechlik, who can test your skills and potentially place you at a higher level of piano than MUS 101A. If you do place out of MUS 101A, you may take the piano course you placed into to complete the piano requirement, or you may choose to study another instrument (not voice) to substitute for the piano requirement. In any case, you must take a course approved by your Musical Theatre advisor to complete this requirement. (Testing out of MUS 101A does not mean that you have completed this requirement!)

[Music Listening/History]:

More advanced music literature/history courses may be substituted for this requirement, with the approval of your Musical Theatre advisor.

DANCE:

The Dance requirement for the Musical Theatre major includes 10 units total:
