* Major Field: Nine credits selected from research (MUS 551, MUS 603, MUS 604, or MUS 655); 21 credits selected from Music Education (including MUS 550, 551, 603, 604, 650, 654, 655, 672, and 696a), with a minimum of three credits in MUS 696a and allowing for MUS 550 and MUS 696a to be repeated when topics/instructors differ; and six credits selected from graduate courses in ethnomusicology, musicology, theory, composition, literature, pedagogy, applied lessons, and ensembles.

Prerequisite: Students are expected to hold a current teaching certificate and to have completed a minimum of three years teaching music full-time in a school. In addition, a Master's degree in Music Education is required. Requests for exceptions to these prerequisites may be submitted to the Coordinator of Music Education for consideration.
