In 2014 our top choirs performed in Vienna's legendary Musikverein and at Dvořák Hall in Prague, and our jazz ensemble and student wind quintet enjoyed successful tours in China. The choral department at the University of Arizona carries on a decades-long tradition of excellence in performance and education, begun under the leadership of John Bloom in 1951. Ten choirs serving over 300 singers provide a range of musical experiences for students of all majors as well as faculty, staff and community members. Any UA student can join a choir regardless of background or level of experience. Departmental ensembles have achieved local, national and international recognition through performances with the Tucson Symphony Orchestra, True Concord Voices and Orchestra, Kronos Quartet, City of Prague Philharmonic and Budapest Chamber Orchestra; appearances at Carnegie Hall, Musikverein (Vienna), Dvorak Hall (Prague); and concerts at the conferences of American Choral Directors Association, Arizona Music Educators Association and College Music Society. Several student-led a cappella groups also provide opportunities for those interested in a different kind of vocal experience.
