Ensemble repertoire includes classical, industrial rock, Broadway, jazz, film scores, and folk music spanning the globe, as well as collaborations with Flutefinity and interdisciplinary projects involving dance and film. Upcoming projects include two performances at Harpa Concert Hall in Reykjavik, Iceland, and for the 2020 American Harp Society National Conference in Orlando, Florida.
