## Bachelor of Music, Performance (Euphonium)

### Fall 2026 Catalog

The BMUS degree requires a minimum of 125 units of which 42 must be upper-division units. (Upper-division courses are numbered 300-499). Admission to this major requires a School of Music application, a music theory placement test and an audition. This major requires a minimum of 89 units of which at least 40 must be upper-division units.

All students enrolled in performance studies (MUSI) are required to participate concurrently in an appropriate large conducted ensemble (MUS 400A-Z). Ensemble placement will be determined by an audition process designed and administered by the ensemble directors in consultation with the applied faculty and as approved by the Director of the School of Music. Accompanying or coached ensembles may fulfill this requirement for keyboard, guitar, jazz studies, or composition majors, per the degree requirements.
